Acts 9: 36-43 (NIV)

<sup>36</sup> In Joppa there was a disciple named Tabitha (in Greek her name is Dorcas); she was always doing good and helping the poor. <sup>37</sup> About that time she became sick and died, and her body was washed and placed in an upstairs room. <sup>38</sup> Lydda was near Joppa; so when the disciples heard that Peter was in Lydda, they sent two men to him and urged him, "Please come at once!" <sup>39</sup> Peter went with them, and when he arrived he was taken upstairs to the room. All the widows stood around him, crying and showing him the robes and other clothing that Dorcas had made while she was still with them. <sup>40</sup> Peter sent them all out of the room; then he got down on his knees and prayed. Turning toward the dead woman, he said, "Tabitha, get up." She opened her eyes, and seeing Peter she sat up. <sup>41</sup> He took her by the hand and helped her to her feet. Then he called for the believers, especially the widows, and presented her to them alive. <sup>42</sup> This became known all over Joppa, and many people believed in the Lord. <sup>43</sup> Peter stayed in Joppa for some time with a tanner named Simon.



# Celebrating the Centennial of the Birthday Offering of Presbyterian Women

The Offering originated in 1922 when Hallie Paxson Winsborough, superintendent of the Women's Auxiliary of the Presbyterian Church, U.S. challenged every woman in the denomination to celebrate the Auxiliary's tenth anniversary by giving an offering to benefit a specific need identified by church leaders. Women were prompted to give "A penny for every year you have lived, and if that is a secret, bring a dollar!" That first year more than \$28,000 was raised for Miss Dowd's School for Girls in Kochi, Japan and to raise the entrance gate at Montreat, where the Auxiliary was originally organized.

Since then the PW Birthday Offering has awarded grants to over 200 projects, helping meet the PW's mission of spreading the Good News of Christ in the United States and beyond. Women's pennies and dollars have been used to build schools, hospitals, homes for children, shelters for victims of violence and for families needing housing. The Offering has also funded programs for teacher training, leadership development, hunger alleviation, and emergency relief.

As we celebrate this 100<sup>th</sup> year of the Birthday Offering, please give in honor of the women who generously gave in years past. Give in hope for the promise of generous Presbyterian Women (and men) who will continue to build this ministry for many years to come.
